

Job Title: Emergency Veterinary Surgeon – Small Animal

Rota: Day-time shifts only

Due to our ongoing expansion, we are looking for a vet with an interest in emergency and inpatient work. You will be confident with routine surgery although your skills and focus will be on managing more complicated procedures and emergencies. You will be comfortable working with the wider Klinic team, but also leading the in-patient shift and managing the unpredictable nature of our emergency cases. This role does not currently involve any OOH work.



Our full-time vets work a 4-day week in Klinic (35 hours), with a fixed day off and a 1:4 Saturday rota, where you will finish at 4pm. There is no out-of-hours or in-patient on call as this is outsourced locally. We have dedicated nurses for our vet shifts, so you will always have someone on hand to help handle patients, write notes, put up meds etc and the fact that clients have real time updates on any hospitalised patient not only provides them peace of mind, but it saves on fielding worried phone calls.



We have protected breaks and admin time, and our dedicated emergency and inpatient shifts mean you don't have to squeeze the unexpected extras around the work you already have.

We believe in the importance of a work-life balance, making the rota flexible in a way that works for each individual team member, so if you're not looking for a full-time position, we would still love to hear from you.
